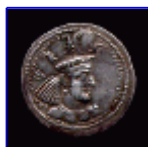
Son of Varhran II. Reign 293 AD. Possibly coins issued; the matter remains unresolved.

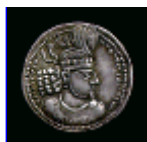

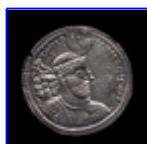
